2. Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists

Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists accredits 15 CME/CPD points (Cat. Non-Ana passive) for the whole programme completed.

3. Hong Kong College of Community Medicine

Hong Kong College of Community Medicine accredits 10 CME/CPD points (Cat. PP) for the whole programme completed.
