

How to record sound to your slide on PowerPoint (Windows 10)

- 1. Please make sure that you have a microphone connected to your computer, if you are using a laptop you should be able to use the internal microphone of the laptop, if not please connect a headset or headphones with a microphone to your computer.
- 2. Open PowerPoint and open your presentation file that contains your poster.
- 3. Click on insert -> Audio -> Record Audio



4. Click on the red recording button and record your voice.



- 5. When you finish click on the stop button.
- 6. You can hear what you recorded if you click on the play button.
- 7. If everything is OK and you are happy with the recording, click on OK and save your presentation file. The audio will become an animation of the e-poster slide. If you want to record again click on cancel and start over.

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How to record sound to your slide on Keynote (Mac)

- 1. Please make sure that you have a microphone connected to your computer, if you are using a laptop you should be able to use the internal microphone of the laptop, if not please connect a headset or headphones with a microphone to your computer.
- 2. Open your keynote file that contains your poster and click on Insert -> Record Audio
- 3. Click on the record button.
- 4. Record your voice, and when you finish click on insert, you can also preview the recording by clicking on preview.
