Course Title/Code:	Public Health Leadership (MMPH6179)
Department:	Community Medicine
Objectives:	 By the end of the course, the students will be able to: 1. Describe the impacts of globalization on human health at the national and global levels; 2. Analyze a range of global health policies and programmes through specific case studies; 3. Demonstrate the roles and responsibilities of key actors in global health and development; 4. Discuss the major challenges for responding effectively to global health challenges through improved global health governance
Content:	This course focuses on the challenges of managing complex health care systems. It will explore the leadership and motivational skills relevant to performing as an effective leader, and discuss the different roles associated with managing the individual, the unit, the organization, and the larger system.
Prerequisitie:	Principles of healthcare management (MMPH6115) or previous healthcare work experience
