## New Online Submission System for CULATR - CARES

We are pleased to inform you of the new online system, Computerized Animal Research Ethics System (CARES), for the handling of CULATR applications and amendments. Researchers requiring approval for animal ethics for their projects are invited to submit applications via CARES. The launch of CARES is in three phases as follows:

Period	Phase
December 6, 2021 to March 31,	Phase 1 - Pilot Launch to selected departments; Hardcopy applications
2022	continue to be accepted
April 1, 2022 to May 31, 2022	Phase 2 - Soft Launch to all; Hardcopy applications continue to be accepted
June 1, 2022	Final Phase - Full Launch; Hardcopy applications no longer accepted

The Secretariat and Committee shall upkeep our commitment in the timely assessment of protocols during peak periods for HMRF and GRF applications through the launch of the new system.

New users requiring accounts or existing users requiring setup in project teams should also submit a request via the same form.
